ARE YOU A STUPID SPELL-BOUND SHEEP?



There is a man that has become quite wealthy with his put down, white-men comedy routine of “You Know You’re A Redneck If...” A few years ago we did a “You Know You’re A Judeo-Christian If...” contest on the radio where people called in their made-up jokes. It was fun and extremely funny. I don’t remember many of them now but here are some of them.

“You know you’re a Judeo-Christian when you show up at the church singles Sunday school class and find that Dr. Ruth is the teacher.”

“You know you’re a Judeo-Christian when the Wednesday night prayer meeting has been replaced with rapture practice. ”

“You know you’re a Judeo-Christian when the church passes the offering plate and there is a credit card machine in it.”

Well, how about a new contest of “You know you’re stupid if...” In other words, how do we know if we are stupid? Do you remember the children’s fairy tale

of “The Emperor’s New Clothes”? It was a story of a cunning Canaanite scam where they convinced the King to give them gold and silver from which they would weave magical cloth, and then use the cloth to make Kingly garments which when the King wore them, he could determine who were the stupid ones in his kingdom. He was told stupid people would see no clothes at all. They would only see a naked king. Of course they were pocketing the gold and silver, playing like they were making the garments, and when they presented the finished outfit to the king, the king was mortified, because he could see nothing. Immediately he thought what he suspected all along, i.e. that he was stupid; but of course he didn’t want to admit that he was stupid, so he carried on like he could see the clothes and ranted and raved of their beauty. His nobles and advisors did likewise, as none of them wanted to appear to be stupid either. Then someone suggested the king have a parade where he could show off his beautiful garments, and at the same time discover who was stupid in his kingdom. So he did, and so the king goes a-strutting and prancing down the street, naked as a jay bird with everyone ooh-ing and aah-ing over the beautiful clothes; now no one could see any clothes, but no one wanted to appear stupid either. Finally, about half-way into the parade, according to the fairy tale, a little child said “the king has no clothes”. Then the people realized he really didn’t have any clothes on. There is more to the fairy tale story to tell you. There is, as one famous news commentator says “the rest of the story”. I have read the original fairy tale story and shall tell you “the rest of the story” later in this article.

No one seems to want to be told they are stupid. In fact, they would think it is not nice, yeah not even Christian, and they would fire the preacher who dared to proclaim such a truth. That kind of truth, stupid people find quite offensive.

In our last newsletter we wrote about the differ-

ence between the un-leavened Barley-loaf that represents the Gideon remnant crowd and the leavened wheat-loaf that represents the greater part of the Church. That part that has been leavened, i.e., Judaized, thus we speak of the Judeo-Christian Church. The Gideon story shows the Gideon go-getters going on the offense. The barley-loaf is offensive. The wheat-loaf is defensive. They will try to defend values, (and try to defend their stupidity), but the Gideon crowd will force Christian values on the land, for they go on the offense. The point is, they don't mind being offensive and even at times see it as their duty to be so.

The prophet Jeremiah is a good example, as he was quite offensive to the stupid people because he told them the truth, that they were stupid.

"For My people are foolish, They know Me not; They are stupid children, And they have no understanding. They are shrewd to do evil, But to do good they do not know."

Jeremiah 4:22

But they are altogether stupid and foolish In their discipline of delusion-- their idol is wood!

Jeremiah 10:8

Is it any wonder the stupid people fought against the prophet? They found him to be quite offensive, but the prophet wasn't backing down and would not be overcome by a stampeding flock of stupid sheep.

Now this preacher is far too refined and sensitive to tell people that they are stupid, lest he offend them. Besides, the way he figures it, it wouldn't do any good anyway. After all, if they are stupid, then they are too stupid to recognize the truth that they are stupid. This puts prophet-type preacher's in a dilemma, because they know they have to preach the truth, offensive or not. So this preacher has come up with a solution. It's called the Stupid Test. "For whoever does these things is detestable to the LORD; and because of these detestable things the LORD your God will drive them out before you. "You shall be blameless before the LORD your God."*
Deuteronomy 18:10-13

Obviously the Bible tells us spells can be cast.

In Part 14 of our "Ask Gideon" series, sub-titled "This Is Not A Drill", (sent out in November on our tape and CD ministry and archived at our website, www.scripturesforamerica.org) this preacher pointed out that witches, sorcerers, spiritualists, etc... had proclaimed Halloween day of October 31, 2004 as a day of prayer for them, to start what they called a "three day rolling spell" in the land. The last day of the spell landed on November 2, the day the dog and pony show called the presidential election ended with people voting.

The election day was a great day of voter turn-out, we are told. A greater turn-out of voters than most past election days because of the moral issues that brought the evangelicals out to vote.

The fact that spell casting is real and really works is seen in the response of these evangelical Christian-type people when the votes were tallied. They wiped the sweat from their nervous, pious brow and said "Whew, that sure was a close one! Praise God that anti-Christ

Kerry didn't get it and our Christian-boy George did! If we had not voted, an un-Christian, pro-abortionist, homo-queer endorsing Kerry would have gotten into office!" Stupid Spellbound Sheep!

In the campaign, the purpose of Mr. Kerry was to make Mr. Bush look good, and he did a good job of it. It's kind of like the job of two cops, who are both on the same side of course, and are working together. They take their assigned roles in the "good cop, bad cop" routine to get from you what they want. But they are both still cops. And so it was with the presidential candidates; good politicians or bad politicians, they are both still politicians and both on the same side.

The meaning of the Hebrew word translated "spell" in Deuteronomy 18:11, according to The New American Standard Exhaustive Concordance by Holman, is; "to unite, be joined, to **tie a magic knot** or spell, to charm." This magical knot is tied when the serpent people and their devil daddy can get you to put two opposites in your mind and believe they are both the same (or in this case, to take two of the very same and get you to believe they are opposites). This is the $1 + 1 = 1$ crowd of stupid spellbound sheep.

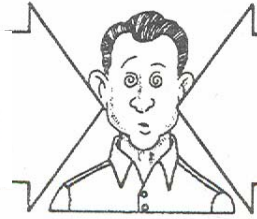
For example, when people say they believe their Bibles and then say they don't believe there are things such as witchcraft, sorcery, Satan and spell-casting. They believe two opposites and accept them both as true, i.e. they have tied them together into a magical knot. 1 (believing the Bible and everything it teaches is true) + 1 (the Bible teaches there is witchcraft, sorcery, spell-casting, but I don't believe it) = 1. In other words, it is all one and the same and no insane contradiction is seen. Such is the insanity of Judeo-Christianity. Another good example is that they believe the definition of being an anti-Christ is to deny that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist. 2 John 1:7

They know the Jews do not believe Jesus is the Son of God, but they still call them "God's Chosen People" rather than the anti-Christ they are. The fact is they will call this preacher an anti-Christ for calling antichrists "anti-Christ" rather than God's Chosen People. To them, Christians who believe Jesus is the Son of God are God's people and those antichrists who oppose Christians and believe Jesus is not the Son of God are also God's people. Yeah, "God's Chosen People". To them, it is all one (1) and the same, but to those not in the spell, it is two (2) separate and opposite things.

Again, getting people to take two opposites and accepting them both as true, i.e. the same, is casting a spell. The 2004 presidential election was the mirror image of this process. In the case of the election, the children of the devil took two of the same and got the people to believe they were opposites. (You might say, in this case, they got them to believe that 1 is not the same as 1 or that $1 \times 1 = 2$). Here is how they reason; "I am against abortion, and someone who is against abortion does not put into office someone who is for abortion. I'm going to vote for Bush because he is against abortion and Kerry is for abortion". Notice the reasoning "someone who is really against abortion does not put someone into office that is for abortion". Then what does their so-called born-again "Christian" president do as soon as he is re-elected? He appoints into the Office of Attorney General Alberto Gonzales, whose public voting record as a former Texas Supreme Court Justice shows that he is not only for abortion, but also advocates underage children being able to get an abortion without parental consent. In this case, Bush and Kerry are one and the same, but to the stupid spellbound sheep they are two separate and distinct candidates. 1 (If you are really against abortion you will not appoint into office someone who is for abortion) + 1 (Mr. Bush is really against abortion and he puts people into office who are for abortion) = 1. It's all one and the same, no contradictions here. No stupidity here. No spell here.

“Well, yeah, but that appointment was made after Mr. Bush was re-elected”, some will say. Yet, before he was re-elected he endorsed and embraced the anti-Christ Jew Senator Alan Spectre, who is openly for even partial-birth abortions!

Knowing that anti-Christ Jew Senator Alan Spectre would most likely be the next chairman of the committee to approve or disapprove Supreme Court Justices, Mr. Bush rushed to rescue Spectre from losing his Senate seat to Pro-life, fiscal-conservative candidate Pat Toomey. During the Pennsylvania Republican Primary, when it appeared that Spectre was losing, Bush went and campaigned for the Senator who not only believes in abortion but in partial-birth abortion to boot. In spite of this, the people really believe that Mr. Bush is against abortion.

They voted against Kerry and for Bush because they believe they stand differently on the issue of the Ten Commandments. When Alabama Supreme Court Justice Roy Moore promoted the Ten Commandments monument, the pro-Bush people knew Senator Kerry would stand against Judge Moore, so they stood against Kerry. In their mind, if you really are for the Ten Commandments, you don't put into office someone who is against the Ten Commandments. Alabama's past Attorney General Bill Pryor was so against the Ten Commandments that he brought ethic charges against Alabama Supreme Court Justice Roy Moore. What does President Bush do as a result? He rewards Mr. Bill Pryor by giving him a Federal Judgeship!



The stupid spellbound sheep reason that Mr. Kerry promotes homosexuals and homosexuality, and that Mr. Bush does not promote such perverts and perversion. However, who did Mr. Bush allow to stand on the stage with him and Mr. Cheney during his victory acceptance speech? Mr. Cheney's homosexual daughter and her queer-pervert dike lover, for multiple millions to see. Yeah, sure, Mr. Bush opposes homosexuality.

One of the definitions of "spell" in Webster's 1828 Dictionary is "that which has the power to subdue opposition and gain the affection." Finally, I could not stand it anymore and I got up and got my wife and the other couple and we started scooting past the other seated people to get out, and while doing so I started yelling "BOO, BOO!!", embarrassing my wife and throwing the startled singer and dancers on stage off que, and causing the audience to stare at us. Then, when part

way out, I had to go back and get a purse one lady had left in her seat, and I kept yelling "BOO, BOO!!" as the singer kept singing "you gotta dance with the devil, you gotta act like the devil, etc... (if you want to get a woman)". When I got out into the lobby, a big 6'2" man came out also and confronted me. He was quite angry in his confrontation and, by this time, the theatre attendant was on the phone calling for ship security to come at once. I was a bit angry myself and when the other big angry man got in my face and asked me why I did what I did, I told him in no uncertain terms that I was a Christian and took great offense at the dirty, lascivious dancing and the devil song, to which he replied that he too was a Christian. The point of the story is his reaction to my reply. I said "What! You're a Christian and you are angry *at* me? Why aren't you angry *with* me!?" He had no answer, it was like he was dumbfounded (like it broke his spell). You see, spells not only subdue opposition to those one should oppose but it also causes opposition to those who are not taken in by the spell, i.e. those who openly and offensively make known their opposition.

Back to the point: The stupid spellbound sheep who believe there is a difference between Mr. Kerry and their beloved leader Mr. Bush not only do not see Mr. Bush as pro-abortion, pro-homosexual and anti-Ten Commandments, they do not oppose his actions, and they do oppose those non-spellbound Christians who do oppose his actions. To the stupid spellbound, his words speak louder than his actions, rather than his actions speaking louder than his words.

*You will know them **by their fruits.** Matthew 7:16*

It is like a preacher who says he opposes homosexuality and abortion, and then appoints as an elder in his church a doctor who runs the local abortion clinic, and appoints as deacon a man who lets his homosexual daughter and her queer lover live together in his house. The stupid spellbound sheep see no contradictions or problems.

The spell casting of putting double think in the minds of the people is done by the serpent people in the media, in politics and **even in the pulpits**. Sometimes it is hard to tell the difference between a stupid shepherd and a sneaky snake. Church pulpits today are full of both. Jeremiah was not above calling stupid shepherds stupid.

For the shepherds have become stupid And have not sought the LORD;... Jeremiah 10:21

I think of the one preacher's "special alert newsletter" that I read, calling for people not to vote for Jesus, but to vote for Christian George Bush and against anti-Christian John Kerry. On first thought, I thought of "stupid shepherd", but also suspected "sneaky snake". To be in the Gideon number we must learn the truth that being suspicious is spiritual, not un-spiritual and judgmental, as the snakes would have you to think; Particularly as in this case where double-think was promoted by that preacher. For after he directs the people to vote for "born-again Christian" George Bush, he states that the Lord Jesus Christ was obviously the best choice. Think of the double-think: "I'm alerting you and directing you, as your Christian, spiritual leader, to vote for George Bush. Don't waste your vote on Jesus, though He is the best choice". Then the guy goes on about how we have to wait for Jesus' return, blah, blah, blah, babble-on, babble-on. As if the Israelites of old could have him as their King without His physical presence (1 Samuel 8), but the Israelites of today cannot. Who do you think such a brilliant guy would have voted for in 1 Samuel Chapter 8 when the people were voting for a physical King over the King that they had?

At least many who voted for Bush reasoned they were voting for the lesser of two evils (which is still voting for evil) and didn't think they were actually voting for a Christian (By the way I have a special preacher's discount for such preachers. Send me just \$500.00 for the magical prayer cloth). Ask yourself if you have ever heard the president mention the name of Jesus Christ. He

mentions "god", but which "god" is he talking about? He is supposedly "born again", but that is terminology also used in the secret skull & crossbones society that both Mr. Kerry and Mr. Bush are members of. It seems to be becoming a POLITICAL divide in this country.

President: Hmm. (Nodding affirmatively).

Terry Moran: And what do you say to those who are concerned about the role of the faith they do not share in public life and in your policies?

President: Yeah, uh. My answer to people is I will be your president regardless of your faith. And I don't expect you to agree with me necessarily on religion. As a matter of fact, no president should ever try to impose religion on our society. The great, uh -- the great tradition of America is one where people can worship the way they want to worship. And if they choose not to worship, you're just as patriotic as your neighbor. This is an ESSENTIAL part of why we are a great nation. And, uh, I'm glad people of faith voted. In this election. I'm glad -- I appreciate ALL people who voted. And I don't think you ought to read anything into the politics of the moment, about whether

or not the nation will, uh, become a, uh, divided nation over religion. I think the great thing that unites us is the fact you can worship freely if you choose and you DON'T have to worship. And if you're a Jew or a Christian or a Muslim you're equally American. That is -- that is such a wonderful aspect of, uh, of our society. And it is strong today and will be strong tomorrow. [11:32:51 a.m. EST]

If I were to have a "You Know You Are Stupid If..." contest on the radio, I suspect some of the callers would call in:

"You know you are stupid if you thought there really was a difference in Mr. Kerry and Mr. Bush."

"You know you are stupid if you support preachers who call Bush a Christian and support him over Jesus."

"You know you are stupid if you thought a Vote for Jesus was a wasted vote, and a vote for Mr. Bush was not."

So what was the Vote for Jesus good for? It helped break the spell and was a scriptural protest vote. When all the other Israelites were voting for a man King, the prophet Samuel voted for God. His objection to their dog and pony show, election of a king, was a protest vote directed by God.

Now therefore hearken unto their voice: howbeit yet protest solemnly unto them, and shew them the manner of the king that shall reign over them. 1 Samuel 8:9

Then, of course, Samuel told them what their freshly voted-for King would do (1 Samuel 8:11-18), including "he will take your sons and place them for himself in his chariots..." The spell will be broken, but one wonders what has to happen for that to come to pass. Do the stupid spellbound sheep have to have their sons (and now daughters also) drafted and placed in his war chariots of today to fight his oil war? On November 4, 2004, right after his re-election, the president said he felt he was given political capital and it was reported on CBS News that he intended to spend it on

his continual “goal to spread freedom across the Greater Middle East.” This of course means more war—which no doubt means invading Iran, which means he will need more sons (and daughters). Will the stupid spellbound gladly provide them, or will the sheep eventually wake up?

The Bible tells us that if we will not receive a love of the truth our God will send us a lie (2 Thessalonians 2:10,11). It seems we are in a “stupor” as it says in Romans 11:8, “*God gave them a spirit of stupor...*” Stupor means “a dazed, helpless, amazed state.” Stupefy means “make stupid or insensible.”

We all have been deceived and spellbound in one way or another at one time or another. We need to repent of being deceived and acknowledge the truth that we’ve been stupid. There is more that could be said and this preacher says more on this subject in the two messages entitled “Stupid Spellbound Sheep” (#1012) and “Dumb & Dumber” (#1013), both of which are to be sent out on the Scriptures for America Tape & CD Ministry. And now, the rest of the story concerning Grimm’s Fairy Tale of “The Emperor’s New Clothes”. We left off with the King parading down the street without any clothes on and the child told the truth, that the King was without clothes. This made the people, including the King, realize the truth. They had been fooled. They were ALL stupid. That is normally where most people stop in the fairy tale story, but the story goes on to say that although the King and the people came to realize the truth, **they continued on with the parade!**

So it will be as the president goes down the street in the inauguration parade. So many people will stupidly cheer on and wave on the charade parade, grateful that they have such a Godly Christian president. Good thing they didn’t waste their vote on Jesus. PJP

91st Days and Sabbaths for 2005

Explanation and Recommendations

December 18, 2004 will be the last 91st Day for the calendar year 2004. The 91st Days for 2005 are as follows.

The spring equinox (March 20, 2005) is the beginning day of the solar calendar. April 2, 2005 is the Passover and it is a most important day. It is the thumb day, the door day. It is a covenant entry day to keeping the next four 91st days. As well as being a day of rest, it is a day to partake of Communion and was kept by the first century church instead of Easter.

Following Passover day, there are four 91st days, which are like soldier Sabbaths and likened as the four fingers on a hand: June 19, 2005, September 18, 2005, December 18, 2005, March 19, 2006. (Note March 19, 2005 is the fourth 91st day for those who entered into this covenant cycle in 2004 and thus there are actually two Sabbath days in a row – March 19 and the spring equinox, March 20, 2005.)

Each day begins at high noon (adjust for daylight savings time when applicable). For proof and understanding that the day begins at high noon, we suggest our four cassette tapes or CD's entitled *The Sabbath*, Parts 1-4, available for a \$15.00 offering from Scriptures for America, PO Box 766, LaPorte, CO 80535.

These Sabbaths are in addition to the regular 7th day "Lord's Day" observed by the early church and Christians today. If you simply cannot observe these Sabbaths the truth of Romans 8:1 is still the promise to the Christian, but we recommend at least the observance of Passover, which the apostles and early church did observe and not Easter. Pray about it and may this writing and the Holy Spirit give you enlightenment as God continues to restore the ancient Hebrews' calendar and Sabbaths to His people.

“The Poison Plot”

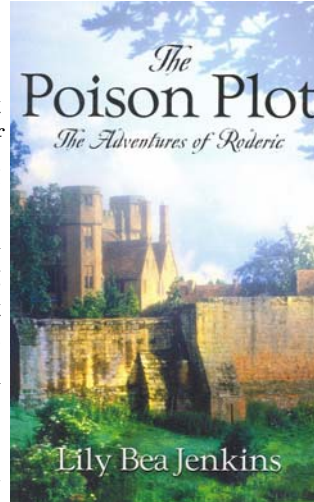

The Poison Plot is the first book in a series, *The Adventures of Roderic*. Miss Jenkins thrills young readers as she incorporates the basic concept of respect for authority in the story line. GOD'S GOING TO RAISE UP MEN, AGAIN



In our special mailing encouraging Christians to pray and fast on Sunday, November 28, 2004, we suggest including in the prayers a request for Him to once again raise up Men of God. Ezekiel 36 tells us that wicked Esau Edom has destroyed real Christian manhood as well as our children's population (through

Ezekiel 36:10,12,13,37, 38

Following is the re-printed article.

Have you ever asked yourself, “Self ... why do churches today look more like the lingerie department at Wal-Mart, than a battalion of men poised to plunder the powers of darkness?” Why do men avoid going to church, and what can be done about it?

Certainly, the lack of men in church is not at all difficult to see. Just open your eyes any Sunday morning and go to church. Then, count the number of ladies in the pews, and the number of men. The result: you’re slapped in the face with the Jose Cuervo-like reality that men are avoiding church like Michael Jackson avoids reality.

More and more, we are seeing fewer and fewer mature and responsible, evil-challenging [men] who love leadership, the struggle and aren’t afraid to boldly face an increasingly godless environment with conviction, power and the love of God.

So why do most men avoid church? Here’s the veneer stripped-away answer: going to church for the majority of men is an exercise in unwanted effeminacy. Church, for most men, has not only become irrelevant; it has also become effeminate. The current lack of strong men within the Church, both in the numeric and leadership sense, has crippled our cathedrals and has helped devastate our nation ethically. - Lose the Church's "I'm in therapy for ever" feel. Yes, yes, we're all a work in progress but the co-dependant, extended womb the Church has wrongfully created has allowed congregants to not get a life because of some difficult doo-doo in their lives. Sure life's hard, little Sally, and the sooner, we celebrate the struggle the quicker we will draw men back to our houses of worship.

If the Church wants to recover its losses, we've got to draw the knuckle draggers back to church. Masculine men are pretty easy. Toss in reason, competition, initiation, struggle, fun and a problem to spiritually throttle, and we'll be there like stink on a monkey. Blow off, suppress, and spiritually emasculate the environment of these holy testicular necessities and your church, as far as men go, will be more empty than an Oktoberfest in Hialeah.
