No god, No Victory

For those who want to be politically and socially correct and those of you who want to try to deceive yourself and others of your scholarly and intellectual brilliance, don't waste your time reading further. Toss this article and the entire newsletter that contains it; but, for those of you who can, as a child of God with childlike faith, believe the simple truth of the word of God, read the following statement. If you can believe it, and at least possibly accept it as maybe true, then read on. You may possibly qualify as a member in the Special Forces that God is going to use as an end-time overcoming, conquering force.

“No god, no victory!”

(Again, if you cannot accept this there is really no need for you to waste your time in reading on).

Isaiah tells us the manner of the end-time victory of good over evil. *“And the Lord of hosts will arouse a scourge against him like the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb, and His staff will be over the sea, and He will lift it up the way He did in Egypt.”* – Isaiah 10:26 (Emphasis added). The slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb was part of the Gideon story. Gideon and his forces were the elite fighting force God used to defeat evil.

The Gideon story is a story of victory over evil, but there would not have been a victory had not Gideon and his men believed in what the Bible teaches about God. The Bible says, *“The fool hath said in his heart there is no God . . .”* – Psalms 14:1. Ask yourself wouldn't Gideon have seemed a fool in the eyes of most to think he could have had victory if he had said; *“There is no God”*?

The story of Gideon is a story of war! War between good and evil. Gideon and his gutsy Gideon core of a few good men were against evil. They saw evil as wrong, which is another way of saying they saw evil as that which is not right. They wanted what was right, not what was wrong. Another word for right is righteousness and there is not much of that left in the land because not many Christians in this land hunger for it, let alone fight for it.

“Blesses are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness for they shall be satisfied.” – Matthew 5:5.

Isaiah 5:20 tells us: *“Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who substitute darkness for light and light for darkness.”*

In the spiritual war around us a satanic sorcery spell has been cast to keep us from seeing evil. That is done in part by having us see evil as good. Think about this – if those on the side of evil cannot be seen, they cannot be fought and conquered. And if evil is made to be seen as good, then good men will not fight against it.

For example, the story of Gideon is a story of a war against good and evil; part of that evil is described in *Judges* 6:1-6 as an invasion:

Then the sons of Israel did what was evil in the sight of the Lord; and the Lord gave them into the hands of Midian seven years. And the power of Midian prevailed against Israel. Because of Midian, the sons of Israel made for themselves the dens which were in the mountains and the caves and the strongholds. For it was when Israel had sown, that the Midianites would come up with the Amalekites and the sons of the east and go against them. So, they would camp against them and destroy the produce of the earth as far as Gaza, and leave no sustenance in Israel as well as no sheep, ox, or donkey. For they would come up with their livestock and their tents, they would come in like locusts for number, both they and their camels were innumerable; and they came into the land to devastate it. So Israel was brought very low because of Midian, and the sons of Israel cried to the Lord.

But, what if Gideon and his men had seen the invasion as good: good for the economy, (cultural diversity is good), good they take jobs we don't do, good for white women to marry dark skinned men and cause white Israel to become extinct?

The story of Gideon is a story of an enemy "Midian" and the enemy's allies – Amalekites and sons of the east - who were (and are) enemies of God and God's people. The story of Gideon is a story of hate; righteous, burning hot hate. The Holy hate the Bible speaks of as David spoke of the enemy:

Do I not hate those who hate Thee, O Lord? And do I not loathe those who rise up against Thee? I hate them with the utmost hatred; they have become my enemies. Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my anxious thoughts; and see if there be any hurtful way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way. – Psalms 139:21-24.

In that spiritual warfare, the satanic spell has put a new religion (considered as a new and better Christianity) in the minds of the people – i.e., "Judeo Christianity" and called it old. So the old Gospel hymn is sung, "Give me that old time religion, give me that old time religion, its good enough for me. It makes me love everybody, etc..."

Do you not think the enemy of God (and of you) want you to love them? The answer is obviously yes. The old hymn should read,

“Give me that old time religion . . . its good for nothing and it ain’t good enough for me to defeat the enemies of evil.” The truth is there is no love of good if there is no hate of evil. The truth is there is no love of God if there is no hate for the enemies of God. David knew this.

The story of Gideon is a story of God. Are we so foolish to think we can have a grand, glorious Gideon victory over evil without God or without believing the truth in the Bible about the **god** spoken of in the Bible? Do you think those on the side of evil want you to believe the truth in the Bible about the **god** spoken of there? The answer is obviously, no.

No – in fact, they’ll ridicule you and laugh at you for doing so. They’ll try to convince you it’s not intellectual and scholarly to do so. They’ll try to fool you (as if you are not foolish enough already). Interestingly enough, the fool caught up in the spell never sees himself as a fool but as wise.

For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God, or give thanks; but they became futile in their speculations and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing to be wise, they became fools. – Romans 1:21-22 NAS.

No god, No Victory

I. HOW THE FOOL EXPLAINS AWAY GOD.

A. The Bible says the fool says there is no God.

B. Here is how the fool that professes to be wise says it: *“Now, it is not exactly that I don’t believe there is a God, but you’ve got to have an intellectual understanding of God. There is a God in that there is a God-like force in all of us, but God, the creator? Well, there is a creative force in all of us which is a guiding force. You see, we all have our own spiritual guide when we are guided by the God within, but it is within us; it is us, my child. It is we. We ourselves; and, we need to learn to love God and believe God – the God within! We need to love ourselves and believe in ourselves – then we will find ourselves; and when we find ourselves, we find God; and when that happens, we soon find our life getting easier and we are able to get to where we want to be.”*, and so Babylon babbles on.

II. HOW DOES ONE RESPOND TO THIS FOOL OR FOOLISH THINKING?

Some minister might argue three points

1. The Bible – tells us clearly there is a God as does the Book of Jasher or the book of Enoch, which are both mentioned in the Bible.

2. Intuitively, you know there is a God, surely you must know. Why, even the dumbest hell-bound heathens in the darkest, deepest jungles know He exists and has power.

3. Look about you and you'll see Him; evidence of Him is everywhere.

Other, less refined ministers might just say, "You fools who fooled you – Repent!" Now repentance means changing your thinking and getting your heart and mind right with God, which means getting in line with the word of God and the Word of God is the Bible.

The Bible tells us there is this god (that this article is talking about) and tells us his name and about his Kingdom. The Bible tells us He's the god of this world: *In whose case the **god of this world** has blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. – II Corinthians 4:4.* (Emphasis added)

The Bible names him: *And he laid hold of the **dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan.** – Revelations 20:2.* . (Emphasis added)

The Bible tells us he influences this world:
We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies in the power of the evil one. – I John 5:19.

So, now, do you still believe the statement, "No god, no victory?" We are talking about the god that *II Corinthians 4:4* is talking about. There is no victory over evil or warring against evil if you don't believe this evil god exists.

Jesus knew he existed and called him the ruler of this world: *I will not speak much more with you, for the ruler of the world is coming, and he has nothing in Me; - John 14:30.*

The Bible tells us Jesus experienced him and heard his call to become one of his children and to do his will:

Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And after He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He then became hungry. And the tempter came and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread." – Matthew 4:1-3.

Again, the devil took Him to a very high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world, and their glory; and he said to Him, "All these things will I give You, if You fall down and worship me." – Matthew 4:8-9.

"Oh, Pastor Peters, you poor, deluded, dumb wanna-be preacher; you has been cowboy that has just rode in off the range. You just don't understand this god. He's the god within all of us." So says the so-called scholarly, intellectual as he explains his twisted, no-devil doctrine.

The no-devil doctrine is as dumb as the no-God doctrine. In fact, it is the same dumb argument of the God within but in reverse. You might say it is just the reverse or mirror image of the same lie. Consider the following comparison on the following chart:

The No-God doctrine described as the god within (The fool hath said there is no God).	The No-Devil doctrine described as the god within—i.e., within our flesh—our fleshly adversary (The fool hath said there is no god).
1. Follow this god and he'll guide you to the good.	1. Follow this god and he'll guide you to the bad.
2. Learn to love our god within and trust him.	2. Learn to hate our god within and do not trust it.
3. Believe in ourselves – i.e., our god within.	3. Do not believe in ourselves – i.e., our fleshly adversary who is the devil.
4. Our god within – i.e., ourselves – will help us get to where we want to be. (It's called believe in yourself).	4. This devil god within our flesh will hinder us from getting to our goals if we believe it and listen to it...

Just as the Bible tells us there is “God”, the Bible tells us there is this “god”. We are simply foolish not to believe the Bible; thus, it is said “*The fool hath said in his heart, there is no God.*” Thus, it could just as rightly be said, “*The fool hath said in his heart, there is no god.*”

The Bible tells us of this god just as it tells us to put no other gods before our God (*Exodus 20:3*). The book of Jasher and the book of Enoch speak of him. Why, even the dumbest hell-bound heathens in the darkest, deepest jungles know he exists and know of his power. And, you know that at times you have experienced his presence, sensed

his call for you to be his child and do his will.

The Bible tells us he has a kingdom, has children, and has a plan but some people say he is not and most live like he is not. Simply put, the devil is and his children are and unless we become as a child with childlike faith and believe the Bible, we'll have no victory over him & them.

Look around you and you'll see evidence that he exists. (The following was taken from an old broadcast of a very well-known news broadcaster).

The Evidence of Him is All Around Us.

If I were the devil . . .

I would gain control of the most powerful nation in the world.

I would convince people that I didn't exist. A mere boogie man of fairy-tales.

I would delude their minds into thinking that they had come from man's effort, instead of God's blessings.

I would promote an attitude of loving things and using people, instead of the other way around.

I would dupe entire states into relying on gambling for their state revenue.

I would convince people that character is not an issue when it comes to leadership.

I would make it legal to take the life of unborn babies.

I would make it socially acceptable to take one's own life, and invent machines to make it convenient.

I would cheapen human life as much as possible so that the life of animals are valued more than human beings.

I would take God out of the schools, where even the mention of His name was grounds for a lawsuit.

I would come up with drugs that sedate the mind and target the young, and I would get sports heroes to advertise them.

I would get control of the media, so that every night I could pollute the mind of every family member for my agenda.

I would attack the family, the backbone of any nation.

I would make divorce acceptable and easy, even fashionable. If the family crumbles, so does the nation.

I would compel people to express their most de-

praved fantasies on canvas and movie screens, and I would call it art.

I would convince the world that people are born homosexuals, and that their lifestyles should be accepted and marveled.

I would convince the people that right and wrong are determined by a few who call themselves authorities and refer to their agenda as politically correct.

I would persuade people that the church is irrelevant and out of date, and the Bible is for the naïve.

I would dull the minds of Christians, and make them believe that prayer is not important, and that faithfulness and obedience are optional.

I guess I would leave things pretty much the way they are.

“No god, no victory.” Do you still believe it? Remember, we said earlier in this article (and I bet most all of you agreed): *“Are we so foolish to think we can have a grand, glorious Gideon victory over evil without God or without believing the truth in the Bible about the God spoken of in the Bible?”* Satan is a god spoken of in the Bible. Are we foolish to believe we can have a grand glorious Gideon victory over evil without believing the truth in the Bible about this evil god?

“No god, no victory.” Rest assured, our enemies, who are of their father the devil and serve him, believe it.

In our p.m. broadcasts of November 8, 9 & 10, 2004, (archived at our website www.scripturesforamerica.org. and available from us on tape or CD) we discussed at length a treatise entitled “The Battle for Your Mind” (subtitled “Persuasion and Brainwashing Techniques Being Used on the Public Today”) by Mr. Dick Sutphen. It is actually taken from a lecture by Mr. Sutphen. The following is his introduction (the bolded text is our emphasis, but the all caps bolded part is his).

THE BATTLE FOR YOUR MIND, by Dick Sutphen
Persuasion & Brainwashing Techniques Being Used on the Public Today

I’m Dick Sutphen and this tape is a studio-recorded, expanded version of a talk I delivered at the World Congress of Professional Hypnotists Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada. Although the tape carries a copyright to protect it from unlawful duplication for sale by other companies, in this case, I invite it.

I am talking about my own business. I know it, and I know how effective it can be. I produce hypnosis and subliminal tapes and, in some of my seminars, I use conversion tactics to assist participants to become independent and self-sufficient.

But, anytime I use these techniques, I point out that I am using them, and those attending have a choice to participate or not.

So, to begin, I want to state the most basic of all facts about brainwashing: IN THE ENTIRE HISTORY OF MAN, NO ONE HAS EVER BEEN BRAINWASHED AND REALIZED, OR BELIEVED, THAT HE HAD BEEN BRAINWASHED. Those who have been brainwashed will usually passionately defend their manipulators, claiming they have simply been “shown the light” . . . or have been transformed in miraculous ways.

Before reading more of his treatise, let us discuss what we have read here. Notice he is a hypnotist and not just a hypnotist, but one who lectures to and teach other hypnotists. He is telling us of “Persuasion and Brainwashing Techniques” being used on us. Notice that the word hypnotic has in it the word “knot” which, as we’ve pointed out in previous writings and sermons, is what the word “spell” in *Deuteronomy* 18:11 means – i.e., a magical knot. He tells us the brainwashed don’t know that they are brainwashed. The Bible describes it as “*and they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will.*” – *II Timothy* 2:26. Also notice he says the brainwashed will passionately defend their manipulators claiming they have simply been “*shown the light.*” (Rest assured some of those who have been fooled to believe there is no devil will defend those who fooled them and claim they have more light and understanding about this god within).

Now, not only has Satan made himself invisible to us by getting us to feel foolish to believe what the Bible tells us about him, (after all, everyone will laugh at us like they laughed at comedian Flip Wilson with his “*the devil made me do it*” comedy routine) but his children do likewise. Mr. Sutphen has been identified as one of Satan’s by not calling the followers of Jesus Christ “Christian” but rather “true believers”:

And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. Therefore, it is not surprising if his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their deeds. – II Corinthians 11:14-15.

Mr. Sutphen wants to be seen as one who is trying to help what he calls “*true believers*” to start believing in their “self” – i.e., “themselves” instead of “outside themselves”. The following is taken from the section of his treatise entitled “*True Believers and Mass Movements*”:

Before ending this section on conversion, I

want to talk about the people who are most susceptible to it and about Mass Movements. I am convinced that at least a third of the population is what Eric Hoffer calls “true believers.” They are joiners and followers . . . people who want to give away their power. They look for answers, meaning, and enlightenment outside themselves.

Before reading more of his statements about “The true believer”, let us read what the Bible tells us about the last days when people are not in their right senses and are held captive by the devil to do his will - that they would be lovers of “self.” (This is a god they love with all their heart, mind, and soul and the god they seek to satisfy and please).

And the Lord’s bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged, with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth, and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will. – II Timothy 2:24-26.

*But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come. For men will be **lovers of self**, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy (emphasis added).*

II Timothy 3:1-

2.

Mr. Sutphen goes on to say:

Hoffer, who wrote THE TRUE BELIEVER, a classic on mass movements, says, “true believers are not intent on bolstering and advancing a cherished self, but are those craving to be rid of unwanted self. They are followers, not because of a desire for self-advancement, but because it can satisfy their passion for self-renunciation!” Hoffer also says that true believers “are eternally incomplete and eternally insecure”!

I know this from my own experience. In my years of communicating concepts and conducting trainings, I have run into them again and again. All I can do is attempt to show them that the only thing to seek is the True Self within. Their personal answers are to be found there and there alone. I communicate that the basics of

spirituality are self-responsibility and self-actualization. But most of the true believers just tell me that I'm not spiritual and go looking for someone who will give them the dogma and structure they desire.

The following shows how he sees the true believers as a dangerous enemy who would convert others to their way and change the way things are. In the war between good and evil, evil does not want an evil society changed. They do not want to see their father's kingdom overcome and conquered by the Kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ. They don't want His laws enforced.

Never underestimate the potential danger of these people. They can easily be molded into fanatics who will gladly work and die for their holy cause. It is a substitute for their lost faith in themselves and offers them as a substitute for individual hope. The Moral Majority is made up of true believers. All cults are composed of true believers. You'll find them in politics, churches, businesses, and social cause groups. They are the fanatics in these organizations.

Mass Movements will usually have a charismatic leader. The followers want to convert others to their way of living or impose a new way of life – if necessary, by legislating laws forcing others to their view, as evidenced by the activities of the Moral Majority. This means enforcement by guns or punishment, for that is the bottom line in law enforcement.

The following quote of Mr. Sutphen speaks for itself and attests to the truth **“no god, no victory.”**

A common hatred, enemy, or devil is essential to the success of a mass movement. The Born-Again Christians have Satan himself.

Then he drives home the truth by basically calling people crazy and stupid for believing in the Bible.

There are mass movements without devils but they seldom attain major status. The True Believers are mentally unbalanced or insecure people.

Gideon and his band were true believers and, as true believers, desirous to be of that Gideon band that overcome evil, we need to know the truth **“no god, no victory.”**

CONCLUSION

It is Satan, not the masons, Jews, bankers, government, illuminati, Hindus, etc., etc., who is the head of the evil about us and no conspiracy as is upon us could exist and function as it does without him. So, people may laugh at you, ridicule you, portray you as simple and unscholarly (and even crazy), but the true Gideon force could care less what the crazy spell-bound captives of Satan call them. To them, it is like the inmates of an insane asylum calling them crazy. They believe the Bible and what the Bible tells them about this god. They know those who serve him want him to be invisible to those who war against evil. They know if you can't see evil good men will not fight, and there will be no war against evil and no victory over it.

As a closing thought, think about this. In most all science fiction-type movies of evil-doing aliens destroying and winning, there is a power source. Cut the power – i.e., cut off the head and it all comes to an end. To never discover and deal with that head is to never have victory. Victory in the days of Gideon happened when they cut off the heads at the rock of Oreb.

And they captured the two leaders of Midian, Oreb and Zeeb, and they killed Oreb at the rock of Oreb, and they killed Zeeb at the wine press of Zeeb, while they pursued Midian; and they brought the heads of Oreb and Zeeb to Gideon from across the Jordan. – Judges 7:25 NAS.

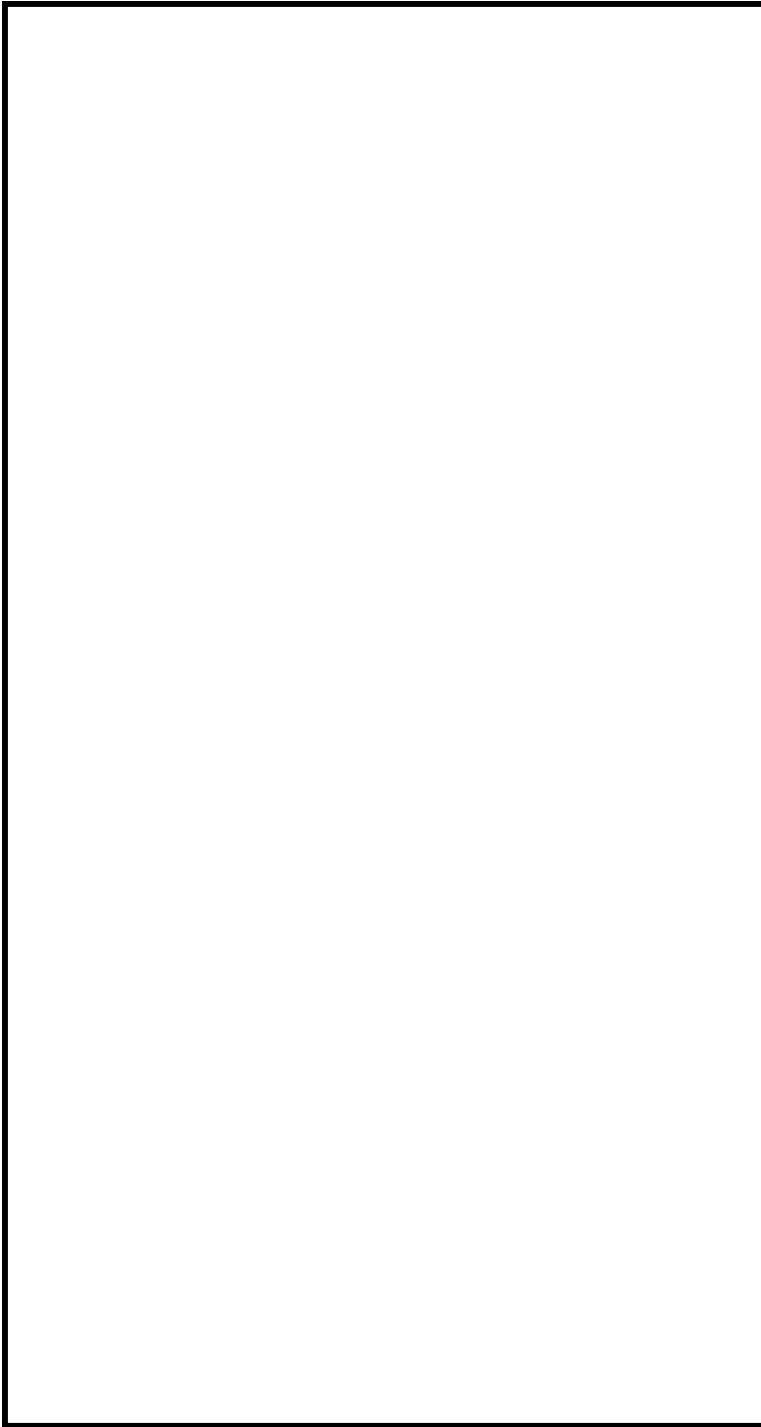
God is going to crush that head and he'll use his people who can see to do it. The following Bible passages attest to this:

And the God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. – Romans 16:20 NAS. (Emphasis added)

*And the Lord God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; on your belly shall you go, and dust shall you eat all the days of your life; And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on **the head**, and you shall bruise him on the heel." – Genesis 3:14-15 NAS (emphasis added).*

There's a war going on. Pray that those ministries that teach there is no devil repent and come to their senses and know that for you to support such is to aid and abet the enemy.

SCRIPTURES ON THE DEVIL AND SATAN

Commentary and study notes:

Strong's definition of the Greek word translated Satan is:
"the accuser, i.e. the devil",

Strong's definition of the Greek word translated devil is:
"a traducer" (i.e. a slanderer, a false accuser)

The devil and Satan is one and the same entity and is also called "the tempter" (see Matt 4:1-3 and vs. 10), the evil one (Matt 13:38), the great dragon and serpent of old (Rev 12).

The Devil knows & uses & quotes Scriptures to promote false doctrine and deceptions (see Matt 4:1-11).

He plants his people in the Kingdom (see Matt 13:38&39).

He takes away the word of Gods from the heart of His people (Luke 8:10-13).

He puts into the heart of men to do evil, even to the extent of betraying the Son of God (John 13:2).

He can oppress some to the point that they need healing (Acts 10:38-39).

If you let the sun go down on your anger, you give the devil an opportunity (Eph 4:25-28).

He has schemes against us, i.e. he schemes against us (Eph 6:11-12).

He is able to ensnare & hold people captive to do his will (II Tim 2:25-26).

He is like a roaring lion seeking someone to devour (I Peter 5:8-9).

He has works (I John 3:8-9).

He deceives, i.e. he is capable of deceiving the whole world (Rev 12:8-9).

He can enter into certain people (Luke 22:3-4).

He can sift people like sifting wheat (Luke 22:31-33).

He can fill your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit (Acts 5:3).

He has a dominion known as the dominion of darkness (Acts 26:16-18).

To combat him is a sword fight; Jesus used Scripture to fight him and then told him to be gone (Matt 4:1-11).

He has angels (Rev. 12:8-9).

Satan falls when we use the authority & power given to us (Luke 10:17-20).

We can be ignorant of his schemes (II Cor 2:10-11).

He disguises himself as an angel of light (II Cor 11:12-15).

Satan hinders us at times (I Thes 2:17-19).

“Power”, “Signs”, & “False Wonders”

can be performed by Satan (II Thes 2:9-10).

Some Christians turn & follow Satan (I Tim 5:14-16).

Satan has a synagogue & a throne (Rev 2:8-10 & 2:12-14).

There is a second MOST important thing to know and learn from the Bible scriptures concerning the devil and Satan. What is it? If you know you will be able to properly complete the following sentence with a two-letter word.

The devil, who is also known as Satan, _____.

The most important thing to know is how to be victorious over him; i.e., how to resist him in your faith, how to keep others from being one of his victims, how to cast him behind you, how not to be deceived by him, etc...

Matt 4:1-11 ...Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And after He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He then became hungry. And the tempter came and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread." But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.'" Then the devil took Him into the holy city; and he had Him stand on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God throw Yourself down; for it is written, 'He will give His angels charge concerning You'; and 'On their hands they will bear You up, Lest You strike Your foot against a stone.'" Jesus said to him, "On the other hand, it is written, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.'" Again, the devil took Him to a very high mountain, and showed Him all

the kingdoms of the world, and their glory; and he said to Him, "All these things will I give You, if You fall down and worship me." Then Jesus said to him, "Begone, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only.'" Then the devil left Him; and behold, angels came and began to minister to Him.

Matt 13:38-39 ...the tares are the sons of the evil one; and the enemy who sowed them is the devil,

Luke 8:10-13 ... "Now the parable is this: the seed is the word of God. "And those beside the road are those who have heard; then the devil comes and takes away the word from their heart, so that they may not believe and be saved.

John 13:2 ... And during supper, the devil having already put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon, to betray Him,

Acts 10:38-39 ..."You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good, and healing all who were oppressed by the devil; for God was with Him.

Eph 4:26-28 ... Be angry, and yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, and do not give the devil an opportunity.

Eph 6:11-12 ... Put on the full armor of God, that you may be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.

1 Tim 3:6-7 ... and not a new convert, lest he become conceited and fall into the condemnation incurred by the devil. And he must have a good reputation with those outside the church, so that he may not fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.

2 Tim 2:25-26 ... with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth, and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will.

Heb 2:14-15 ... Since then the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil;

devil and he will flee from you.

1 Peter 5:8-9 ... Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls about like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. But resist him, firm in your faith,

1 John 3:8-9 ...The Son of God appeared for this purpose, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Rev 2:10-11 ...'Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

Rev 12:8-9 ... And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Mark 3:22-27 ...And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem were saying, "He is possessed by Beelzebub," and "He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons." And He called them to Himself and began speaking to them in parables, "How can Satan cast out Satan? "And if a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. "And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. "And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but he is finished! "But no one can enter the strong man's house and plunder his property unless he first binds the strong man, and then he will plunder his house.

Mark 4:15-16 ... "And these are the ones who are beside the road where the word is sown; and when they hear, immediately Satan comes and takes away the word which has been sown in them

Luke 10:17-20 ...And the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name." And He said to them, "I was watching Satan fall from heaven like lightning. "Behold, I have given you authority to tread upon serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall injure you. "Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven."

Luke 22:3-4 ... And Satan entered into Judas who was called Iscariot, belonging to the number of the twelve.

Luke 22:31-33 ..."Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has demanded permission to sift you like wheat; but I have prayed

for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers. "

Acts 5:3 ... But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit, and to keep back some of the price of the land?"

Acts 26:16-18 ... 'But arise, and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to appoint you a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you; delivering you from the Jewish people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you, to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, in order that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

Rom 16:17-20 ... Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them. For such men are slaves, not of our Lord Christ but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting. For the report of your obedience has reached to all; therefore I am rejoicing over you, but I want you to be wise in what is good, and innocent in what is evil. *And the God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet.*

1 Cor 5:5 ... I have decided to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

1 Cor 7:5-6 ... Stop depriving one another, except by agreement for a time that you may devote yourselves to prayer, and come together again lest Satan tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

2 Cor 2:10-11 ... But whom you forgive anything, I forgive also; for indeed what I have forgiven, if I have forgiven anything, I did it for your sakes in the presence of Christ, in order that no advantage be taken of us by Satan; for we are not ignorant of his schemes.

2 Cor 11:12-15 ... For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. Therefore it is not surprising if his servants also dis-

guise themselves as servants of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their deeds.

1 Thes 2:17-19 ... For we wanted to come to you-- I, Paul, more than once-- and yet Satan thwarted us.

2 Thes 2:9-10 ... that is, the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders,

1 Tim 5:14-16 ...Therefore, I want younger widows to get married, bear children, keep house, and give the enemy no occasion for reproach; for some have already turned aside to follow Satan.

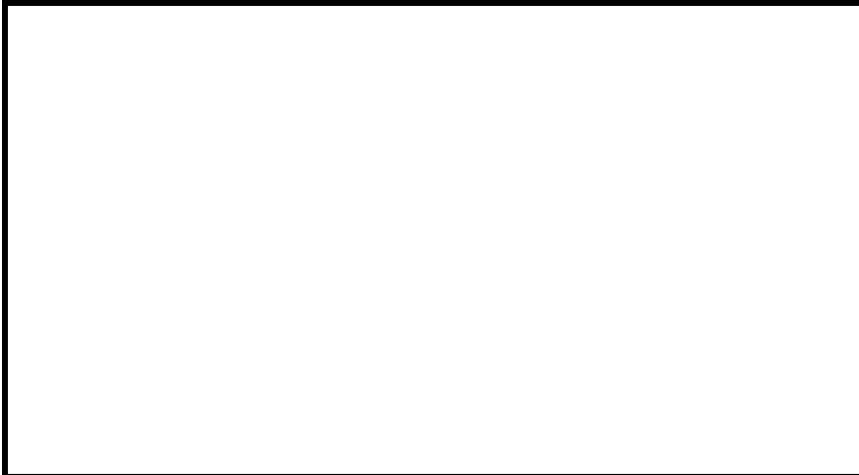
