

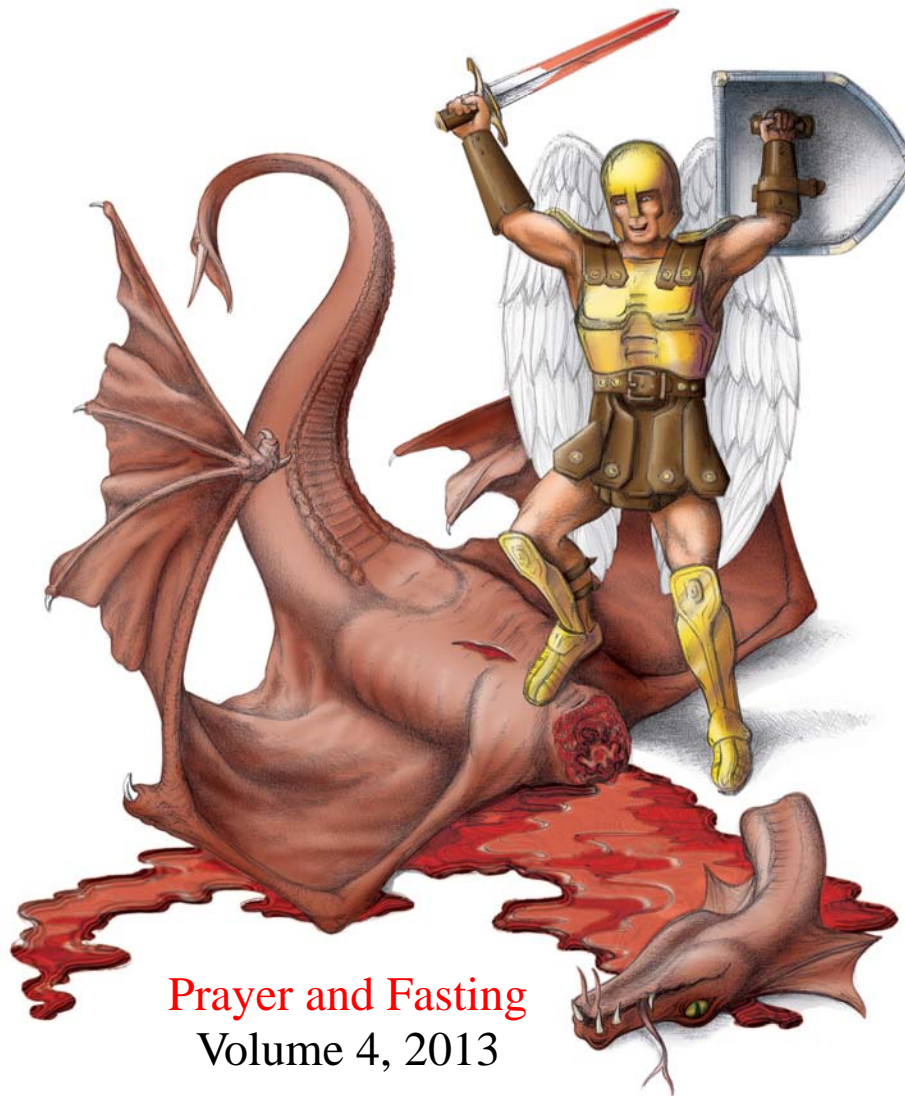

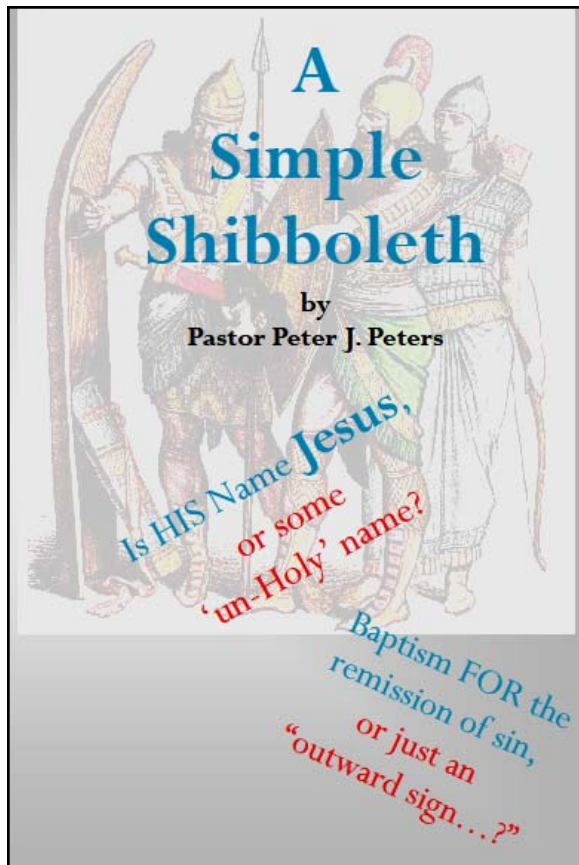

**Greetings** to the once lost but now found sheep of the House of Israel!  
Do you know what the Bible has to say about fasting? There are many Biblical reasons to fast, and all of them will be covered later in this article.

This Church (a group of believers) is calling for the brethren to join together, as one body, in a fast, in preparation for this year's Branson-area gathering.

We are petitioning you, the true remnant, to commit to at least **one day** of fasting, as directed here, between May 1, and June 9, 2013. As we prepare to start this Holy Spirit inspired and directed **forty-day** fast, we must understand the critical importance of making, honoring and fulfilling this commitment.

We will dedicate that day to the LORD, and our commitment is that our fast is to remain secret from the world, so that we will not be noticed by men (Matthew 6:16-18). We will anoint our heads and seek God's face, we will immerse ourselves in the Word of God, and we will humbly prostrate ourselves before the LORD, earnestly seeking forgiveness for our personal as well as our national sins.

The SFAW men will cover from noon June 6th through noon June 9th. We request that you please contact our office (at 307-742-7582 or preacher@sfaw.org) as to which day you are willing to commit to. We will keep a calendar to make sure each day is covered, and that we will have at least two or three believers committed to each day of the fast. This will ensure that there will be no hidden reefs in our love feast; that is, that no one person can be a deceiver and break the fast. Any days not covered by at least two believers will be covered by the men here at SFAW, including myself if necessary.

Not all will be able to heed this call, and not all should. However, pray about it, and if you are Holy-Spirit led to fast with us, and agree to stay within the guidelines, welcome and thank you!

## Prayer and Fasting

Fasting means self-denial by going without food, drink or both for a period of time. There are many reasons to fast and the Bible gives us specific examples of each one.



**Distress and Grief:** Loss of appetite is a natural reaction in times of distress, grief and mourning. Fasting was considered appropriate at these times.

David fasted as a sign of grief in 2 Samuel 3:35.

*Then all the people came to persuade David to eat bread while it was still day; but David vowed, saying, "May God do so to me, and more also, if I taste bread or anything else before the sun goes down."*

2 Samuel 3:35

There was a seven-day fast at the death of Saul.

*And they took their bones and buried them under the tamarisk tree at Jabesh, and fasted seven days.*

1 Samuel 31:13

**Spiritual Preparation:** Fasting is a self-sacrifice that makes one humble and more accepting of God's will.

Moses fasted for forty days in preparation for receiving the Ten Commandments.

*So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did not eat bread or drink water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.*

Exodus 34:28

Daniel fasted for three weeks before receiving his vision in Chapter 10.

*I did not eat any tasty food, nor did meat or wine enter my mouth, nor did I use any ointment at all, until the entire three weeks were completed.*

Daniel 10:3

Elijah fasted forty days before speaking with God.

*So he arose and ate and drank, and went in the strength of that food forty days and forty nights to Horeb, the mountain of God.*

1 Kings 19:8

Jesus fasted for forty days in preparation for His temptation by the devil.

*Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And after He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He then became hungry. And the tempter came and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread." But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.'"* Matthew 4:1-4

### **Repentance and Atonement:**

When Jonah predicted the downfall of Nineveh, the Ninevites fasted as a sign of repentance in hopes God would spare their city.

*So Jonah arose and went to Nineveh according to the word of the LORD. Now Nineveh was an exceedingly great city, a three days' walk. Then Jonah began to go through the city one day's walk; and he cried out and said, "Yet forty days and Nineveh will be overthrown." Then the people of Nineveh believed in God; and they called a fast and put on sackcloth from the greatest to the least of them. When the word reached the king of Nineveh, he arose from his throne, laid aside his robe from him, covered himself with sackcloth, and sat on the ashes. And he issued a proclamation and it said, "In Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles: Do not let man, beast, herd, or flock taste a thing. Do not let them eat or drink water. But both man and beast must be covered with sackcloth; and let men call on God earnestly that each may turn from his wicked way and from the violence which is in his hands. "Who knows, God may turn and relent, and withdraw His burning anger so that we shall not perish?"*

Jonah 3:3-9

When the Israelites had sinned, they often humbled themselves and fasted in hopes of regaining God's favor.

*Then all the sons of Israel and all the people went up and came to Bethel and wept; thus they remained there before the*

*Lord and fasted that day until evening. And they offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the Lord.* Judges 20:26

*They gathered to Mizpah, and drew water and poured it out before the Lord, and fasted on that day and said there, "We have sinned against the Lord." And Samuel judged the sons of Israel at Mizpah.* 1 Samuel 7:6

Also look at 1 Samuel 1:15; Psalm 62:8; Lamentations 2:19; Leviticus 16:29; Nehemiah 9:1; Judges 10:10; 1 Kings 8:47; and Psalm 106:6.

In both the Old and New Testaments, fasting was used as a useful means for humbling oneself, as a sign of commitment or repentance and for increasing faith, especially when accompanied by prayer. Fasting allowed you to be devoted to spiritual matters without distraction from the worldly things.

When we fast, do we fast properly? Isaiah tells us how to.

*"Why have we fasted and Thou dost not see? Why have we humbled ourselves and Thou dost not notice?" Behold, on the day of your fast you find your desire, And drive hard all your workers. "Behold, you fast for contention and strife and to strike with a wicked fist. You do not fast like you do today to make your voice heard on high. "Is it a fast like this which I choose, a day for a man to humble himself? Is it for bowing one's head like a reed, And for spreading out sackcloth and ashes as a bed? Will you call this a fast, even an acceptable day to the LORD? **Is this not the fast which I choose, To loosen the bonds of wickedness, To undo the bands of the yoke, And to let the oppressed go free, And break every yoke? "Is it not to divide your bread with the hungry, And bring the homeless poor into the house; When you see the naked, to cover him; And not to hide yourself from your own flesh? Then your light will break out like the dawn, And your recovery will speedily spring forth; And your righteousness will go before you; The glory of the LORD will be your rear guard. Then you will call, and the LORD will answer; You will cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.'*** If you remove the yoke from your midst, The pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, And if you give yourself to

*the hungry, And satisfy the desire of the afflicted, Then your light will rise in darkness, And your gloom will become like midday."*

Isaiah 58:3-10

Jesus taught us that fasting, like prayer, is between you and God! It's not for show! This is a Scripture I wished I had understood earlier in life. Over the years I have fasted many times, for important reasons. Not knowing this truth, I did not fast properly according to God's Word. Could it be I hindered my reward from the Heavenly Father?

*"And whenever you fast, do not put on a gloomy face as the hypocrites do, for they neglect their appearance in order to be seen fasting by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full. But you, when you fast, anoint your head, and wash your face so that you may not be seen fasting by men, but by your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will repay you."*

Matthew 6:16-18

*"And when you pray, you are not to be as the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners, in order to be seen by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full. But you, when you pray, go into your inner room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees in secret will repay you."*

Matthew 6:5-6

John the Baptist's disciples routinely fasted according to the Word, but Jesus and His disciples did not. However, Jesus said His disciples would mourn and fast after He had left them. The question about fasting is found in Mark 2:18-20.

*And John's disciples and the Pharisees were fasting; and they came and said to Him, "Why do John's disciples and the disciples of the Pharisees fast, but Your disciples do not fast?" And Jesus said to them, "While the bridegroom is with them, the attendants of the bridegroom do not fast, do they? So long as they have the bridegroom with them, they cannot fast. But the days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast in that day."*

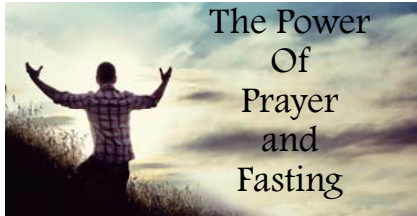

## Prayer and Fasting

There are also two other accounts of this, in Matthew 9:14-15 and in Luke 5:33-35. There is evidence that the early Christians practiced fasting at least occasionally.

*And while they were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Then, when they had fasted and prayed and laid their hands on them, they sent them away.*



Acts 13:2-3

*And when they had appointed elders for them in every church, having prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord in whom they had believed.*

Acts 14:23

In 2 Corinthians 11:27, the Apostle Paul tells us: *I have been in labor and hardship, through many sleepless nights, in hunger and thirst, often without food, in cold and exposure.*

Fasting is not forced or contrived, but necessitated for the purpose of prayer, soul-searching, seeking God's wisdom and direction, and calling out for change. We need to be mindful that there are no gold medals for those who can go the longest without food or the most often without food.

Fasting is for increased focus, not for famine. Sometimes we fast to do the work of ministry. Sometimes we will fast alone, while yet at times we will fast with others who feel the same burden that we do. The following comes from Nehemiah:

*And they said to me, "The remnant there in the province who survived the captivity are in great distress and reproach, and the wall of Jerusalem is broken down and its gates are burned with fire." Now it came about when I heard these words, I sat down and wept and mourned for days; and I was fasting and praying before the God of heaven. And I said, "I beseech Thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and awesome God, who preserves the covenant and lovingkindness for those who love Him and keep His commandments, let Thine ear now be attentive and Thine eyes open to hear the prayer of Thy servant which I am praying before Thee now, day*

*and night, on behalf of the sons of Israel Thy servants, confessing the sins of the sons of Israel which we have sinned against Thee; I and my father's house have sinned. We have acted very corruptly against Thee and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the ordinances which Thou didst command Thy servant Moses. Remember the word which Thou didst command Thy servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful I will scatter you among the peoples; but if you return to Me and keep My commandments and do them, though those of you who have been scattered were in the most remote part of the heavens, I will gather them from there and will bring them to the place where I have chosen to cause My name to dwell.' And they are Thy servants and Thy people whom Thou didst redeem by Thy great power and by Thy strong hand. O Lord, I beseech Thee, may Thine ear be attentive to the prayer of Thy servant and the prayer of Thy servants who delight to revere Thy name, and make Thy servant successful today, and grant him compassion before this man." Now I was the cupbearer to the king. Nehemiah 1: 3-11*

These verses end with Nehemiah telling us an interesting thing. *Now I was the cupbearer to the king.* So what was the cup bearer? You will have to read the detailed and important answer to that question in next-months edition of the DragonSlayer.

*So I gave my attention to the Lord God to seek Him by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes.*

Daniel 9:3

*So we fasted and sought our God concerning this matter, and He listened to our entreaty.*

Ezra 8:23

A spiritual fast involves our hearts and the way in which we relate to and trust God. It relates to discerning and receiving strength to follow through on what God might reveal to us about circumstances in our lives, or a direction we are to take.

Jesus said in Matthew 26:41: *"The spirit is . . . willing, but the flesh is weak."* Fasting is a means of bringing the flesh into submission to the LORD so He can strengthen us in our mastery over our own selves.

Fasting, in the flesh, makes us stronger to stand against the temptations of the flesh.

Just as in the Garden of Eden when the serpent tempted Eve, the devil's insistent question is likely to become very loud in our minds as we begin a fast; "Has God really said you can't eat? Not anything? Not the things you love the most? Has God really called you to fast-to abstain totally?"

Our answer must be a firm, "Get thee behind me Satan! Yes! God has called me to fast. He has called me to give my full attention to Him and to His commandments. He has called me to obey Him fully in all things. And God has called me to say no to you, devil!"

*But I am afraid, lest as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds should be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ.* 2 Corinthians 11:3

We, the remnant, must find our way back to the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ! It is my sincere prayer that this commitment we make, as the body of Christ, will do just that. The time is right, the time is now!

So remember, we are asking the Christian remnant to commit to fasting for at least **one day** between May 1, and June 9, 2013. We ask you to contact our office as to which day you can commit to, and we will keep a calendar to make sure each day is covered.

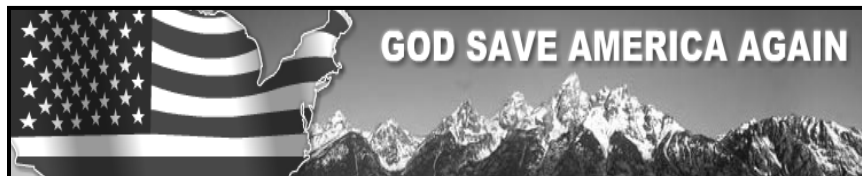
We would like those of you who have been a part of the music program for past meetings to help out again this year. And . . .

## THE POWER OF NO!

### THE POWER, BLESSINGS AND CURSES OF NO!

Some of the most powerful words in our English vocabulary are not necessarily large. As a matter of fact, if you speak with small direct words you will be called direct or brisk. Yet, when someone annoys us or is being “difficult” we say, “I will use small words so you can understand.” That is because they are direct and to the point and allow no room for wiggle. They are absolute!

We tell our children to say, “No,” to many things... drugs, peer pressure, premarital sex, and the temptations of this world. All too often we don't practice “no” ourselves in our daily lives as an example to them. We cave in, knuckle under, and waffle (even for some of the small things for us) and miss an opportunity for our young people to see it happen and feel the awe of the power of God by using the big word, NO. Remember “no” is conveyed in many negative actions as well. An example would be Jonah fleeing out of the presence of God. He was definitely being rebellious in spirit... rebellious = negative = no = swallowed by a whale = yes to wayward self = God's judgment.

Whenever we say, “NO” to something, by default we say, “Yes,” to something else. *“But let your statement be, ‘Yes, yes’ or ‘No, no’; and anything beyond these is of evil.”* Matthew 5:37

As a nation, God's people say, “Yes,” to almost everything that comes down the pike (either intentionally or unknowingly). These default affirmatives have been going on since the garden. The costs are beginning to show. It always costs something to do anything... good or bad. Unfortunately, for quite a few years, people have valued being amicable and socially acceptable above being Godly.

Some may be familiar with the electrical term known as “grounding.” There are two sides on a battery: the (+) positive end and the (-) negative end. Another name for the negative is ground. Lately there has been an amazing trend in natural healthcare, called “earthing.” As a people, we have become ungrounded; insulated both morally and physically and it is affecting our health both physically and spiritually in a negative way. When we ground our-

selves to the earth by getting our bare feet on the ground, our health and well being/frequency is improved. Likewise using “yes” and “no” is a way for us to make the circuit. God's plan is like a printed circuit/path and your “yes” or “no” is the switch that determines the outcome.

*And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose. For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the first-born among many brethren;* Romans 8:28-29

When we say someone or something is “grounded” in electrical terms we are referring to the negative aspect of electricity. In order to have a circuit you must have connection to both the positive and the negative aspect of the power. If something is not connected in the circuit, it is called an “open” and the power will not flow. God is the power source (battery) and for us to make the power flow (work) we have to have a circuit with both positive and negative connections!

Negative can also mean “no” just as positive can mean “yes.” The similarities between power and the heavenly realm is not my focal point here. There are so many analogies in electricity, we will move on using the above as a reference. We can learn how to make the circuit by getting “GROUNDED” in Godly matters so that the power flows or we will continue to be weak, lukewarm, browbeaten Christians. Yes, it's so friendly and inviting, but it is a siren's song. The consequences for using “no” in the wrong way are usually swift and sharp. “Yes” has consequences too. Just as yes and no are opposites, so the punishments can be for using “yes” without discernment (long and drawn out until the inevitable end when understanding dawns upon the mind).

“NO,” is a militant term, don't you think? Just saying, “NO,” can land you in more trouble than any other word. It can also bring tremendous blessings. In order to become more mature Christians' we must learn to judge the times, to be discerning in the use of the positive and negative aspects of matters before us.

*Do you not know that we shall judge angels? How much more, matters of this life?* 1 Corinthians 6:3

*On the lips of the discerning, wisdom is found, But a rod is for the back of him who lacks understanding.*

Proverbs 10:13

There are places not to say “No”. For example, one does not say, “No” to God. Korah's tirade to Moses comes to mind.

*Then it came about as he finished speaking all these words, that the ground that was under them split open; and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them up, and their households, and all the men who belonged to Korah, with their possessions. So they and all that belonged to them went down alive to Sheol; and the earth closed over them, and they perished from the midst of the assembly. And all Israel who were around them fled at their outcry, for they said, "The earth may swallow us up!" Fire also came forth from the LORD and consumed the two hundred and fifty men who were offering the incense.*

Numbers 16:31-35

Korah literally got to “go to hell” for telling God, “No”. The flip side of this “no” study is that the rewards can be great when the circuit is completed and the power (from God) flows. Gideon used the power of “no” many times, and our Bible is overflowing with examples.

*Then the angel of the LORD came and sat under the oak that was in Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite as his son Gideon was beating out wheat in the wine press in order to save it from the Midianites. And the angel of the LORD appeared to him and said to him, "The LORD is with you, O valiant warrior."*

Judges 6:11-12

Gideon was beating out the wheat in a wine press because he was telling the Midianites “NO” and he did not fear them. And he was called a valiant warrior for the LORD.

*Now the same night it came about that the LORD said to him, "Take your father's bull and a second bull seven years old, and pull down the altar of Baal which belongs to your father, and cut down the Asherah that is beside it; and build an altar to the*

*LORD your God on the top of this stronghold in an orderly manner, and take a second bull and offer a burnt offering with the wood of the Asherah which you shall cut down." Then Gideon took ten men of his servants and did as the LORD had spoken to him; and it came about, because he was too afraid of his father's household and the men of the city to do it by day, that he did it by night.*

Judges 6:25-27

Here we see Gideon using the power of "NO" to pull down the baals. He conquered the fearful side of "no" by doing it at night! Remember, saying "no" is an action or results in action!

Then there is Peter and the Apostles who used the power of "NO" without fear, and God vindicated and protected them. They did it daily. Read your Bible for more, once you begin to see the powerful uses of "no," they are everywhere.

*And when they had brought them, they stood them before the Council. And the high priest questioned them, saying, "We gave you strict orders not to continue teaching in this name, and behold, you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us." But Peter and the apostles answered and said, "We must obey God rather than men. "The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you had put to death by hanging Him on a cross. He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. And we are witnesses of these things; and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him." But when they heard this, they were cut to the quick and were intending to slay them.*

Acts 5:27-33

Fear is a negative response. We can therefore know that fear is a part of "no" that we are not to allow because we are told to fear not.

*But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, you are blessed. AND DO NOT FEAR THEIR INTIMIDATION, AND DO NOT BE TROUBLED.* 1 Peter 3:14 (*emphasis added*)

You must tell fear, "NO." It is the reverse side of the coin of "no" as we discern its right and wrong uses. It reminds me of the NO FEAR sports ad gimmick.

## THE POWER OF NO!

Actually I think my ad for God's version of NO FEAR would be;

### **No Jesus, Know Fear; Know Jesus, No Fear.**

There is an axiom in mathematics that when multiplying negative numbers the product is positive. This is not only possible but probable in the Biblical examples we are given. By fearing God more than man we are multiplied and a negative answer to their negative action creates a positive outcome for God's people and His Kingdom. When we fear God, we follow God. When we follow God's laws, we activate God's power for us through our obedience to Him and our lives are multiplied to the infinite.

*Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food, will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness; you will be enriched in everything for all liberality, which through us is producing thanksgiving to God.*

2 Corinthians 9:10-11

*For when God made the promise to Abraham, since He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, "I WILL SURELY BLESS YOU AND I WILL SURELY MULTIPLY YOU."*

Hebrews 6:13-14 (emphasis added)

Now I hope we are gaining some discernment in the power of "NO" as a spiritual weapon of great power.

*Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ; so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; in no way alarmed by your opponents-- which is a sign of destruction for them, but of salvation for you, and that too, from God.*

Philippians 1:27-28

### **Knowingly Using "No" in Today's World**

*"Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves; therefore be shrewd as serpents, and innocent as doves.*

Matthew 10:16

God's people need knowledge and discernment to use the weapon of "NO." People tend to say, "Yes" more than they ought because it is a peaceful solution at that moment in time.

If one does not stand and say, “NO,” then yes is the default assumption in our society, or worse you are considered not to have an opinion, which is a lukewarm position. Down the road a default “yes” may bear harsh fruit for our children, or kinsmen, even ourselves; but it is the non conflict way around obstacles. The Apostle Peter got a lesson from Jesus that we should be anxious to learn from.

*And when they had come to Capernaum, those who collected the two-drachma tax came to Peter, and said, "Does your teacher not pay the two-drachma tax?" He said, "Yes." And when he came into the house, Jesus spoke to him first, saying, "What do you think, Simon? From whom do the kings of the earth collect customs or poll-tax, from their sons or from strangers?" And upon his saying, "From strangers," Jesus said to him, "Consequently the sons are exempt. But, lest we give them offense, go to the sea, and throw in a hook, and take the first fish that comes up; and when you open its mouth, you will find a stater. Take that and give it to them for you and Me."*

Matthew 17:24-27

Poor Peter was caught here in the trap of the “yes-men,” and Peter paid for it as he learned. Now we can learn from his example. The first thing Jesus asked Peter was why he said, “yes,” instead of “no.” In my mind I tend to put an exclamation point after the words, “what do you think.” The KJV puts it “*what thinkest thou, Simon.*” I personally don't think it was as much of a question as an admonishment. My Dad's voice echoes in my mind at some of the times I was part of the “yes men” with the words, “WHAT WERE YOU THINKING!”

We also note the use of Peter's pre-apostolic name Simon, referring to his old self before the fear-destroying power of Jesus Christ had come into his life. It should be noted that Jesus was not concerned about offending the collectors by telling them “NO,” but rather offending any by not following Matthew 5:37, through the hypocrisy of not taking a stand. It should be noted that Christ did not capitulate to their demands per se, but sent

Simon back to his old occupation of fishing to pay the bill Simon agreed to.

The Sons and Daughters of Jesus Christ are free in Him because he paid for everything! Jesus Christ and His disciples are opponents of Satan's new (old) world order because they don't go with the flow! Real change requires the discerning and forcible use of the word "NO." Force? What kind of force? Jesus gave us an example of using force to implement "NO":

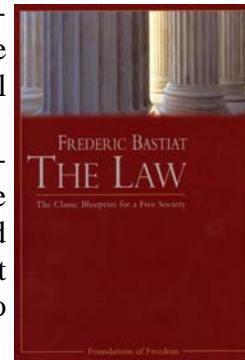
*And the Passover of the Jews was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. And He found in the temple those who were selling oxen and sheep and doves, and the moneychangers seated. And He made a scourge of cords, and drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and the oxen; and He poured out the coins of the moneychangers, and overturned their tables; and to those who were selling the doves He said, "Take these things away; stop making My Father's house a house of merchandise." His disciples remembered that it was written, "ZEAL FOR YOUR HOUSE WILL CONSUME ME."*

John 2:13-17 (emphasis added)

Our spiritual walk demands the use of the word "NO" to avoid defilement (see Mark 7:18-23). Frederick Bastiat in his book, THE LAW, wrote; "When law and morality contradict each other the citizen has the cruel alternative of either losing his moral sense or losing his respect for the law."

As a Christian people, our moral compass comes from the inspired word of God, the Bible. And so do ALL Laws (God's Laws and precepts). These rules we face today are not laws; man cannot create Law; only God can do that. It is His divine right.

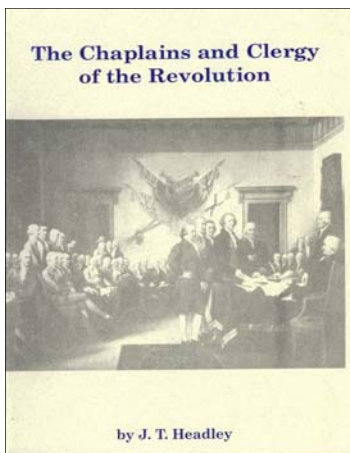
*There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the One who is able to save and to destroy; but who are you who judge your neighbor?* James 4:12



## THE POWER OF NO!

If we write laws from our own imperfection we are then judging our neighbor unjustly. The laws we face today are made by the “yes men,” for the “yes men's” benefit. The power of “NO” shatters their power. So the pimps in the pulpits are very quiet about it or they won't get their 501(c)3 tax-free church-status renewed next year! The only “no” they preach about are: no drinking, no smoking, no resistance to antichrist rulers, no intolerance, no discrimination, no confrontation, and no condemnation. They preach that “yes” is always better (you catch more flies with honey). God doesn't want flies though. He wants men and women of courage and conviction who can stand and say, “NO,” when the time is right!

Another good example of people who stood for God and opposed ungodly rulers is found in The Book of Maccabees in the Apocrypha, originally found in the Bible. We are commanded as Christians to judge, discriminate, and choose, for the furthering of the Kingdom of Christ on this earth and in heaven. because we are told:

*"Truly I say to you, whatever you shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on*

*earth shall be loosed in heaven. "Again I say to you, that if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven. Matthew 18:18-19*

Many may well quote Matthew 7 as a reason to simply say, “Yes.”

*"Do not judge lest you be judged. "For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you.*

Matthew 7:1-2

## THE POWER OF NO!

When they always just say, “Yes,” they fail to connect with God so that the power doesn’t flow. Mathew 7:1-2 is a disclaimer. Yes, God has disclaimers too, not a prohibitive command.

When we judge, we will be judged by the same measure. Thank God we can use the Bible for that yardstick, as it does not change (unlike man's law). I do not have to fear being judged, because Jesus Christ is my advocate and His sacrifice was payment for my shortcomings. The only ones who fear this Judge's judgments are the parasitic, tare, “yes-men (and women)” who are outside the fold of Christ's sacrifice.

We are not to judge our brethren harshly within the fold, but we are warned about being a lackey to the world. Those outside the fold have no such protection, because they have not been baptized for the remission of sins, and Christ's blood does not cover their sins. Misery loves company, and Satan's peoples plan on getting all the company they can.

*You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. James 4:4*

*The LORD nullifies the counsel of the nations; He frustrates the plans of the peoples. Psalm 33:10*

When this government we live under these days (by the people, of the people, for the people and without God) gets out of control, God nullifies their counsels. In short he tells them “NO”.

With all the gun control and people control and money control issues we face today (as this antichrist government tries to micro-manage everything we do and say), I want to encourage you to know how to say, “NO.” Have you ever said, “NO,” and watched their face? It is like you dealt them a physical blow. When you offer no explanation, no extenuating circumstance, just righteous belligerence, then they are speechless (most of the time). I remember my wife's dad's indignation after a home school battle in the seventies when the court appointed a social worker to check up on his daughter at their home.

His simple response was, "NO, that is not going to happen here," as he explained what no meant to the social worker. The fear on her face was evidence of the power of NO. They never showed up, not once, despite the court order for them to do so.

The reason I am going into Biblical nullification is because we need to know it as another "NO" in our arsenal. I mentioned earlier in this article that problems with knowing how to use the power of "NO" were as old as the garden. Adam failed to nullify Eve's actions and said, "Yes," by partaking of her sin, thus passing the sin and suffering on to all of their children down through the ages to present day. God gave us another opportunity with the new JerUSAlem in America. There are some serious snake boys," satan's "yes men" trying to destroy what has been built here. We know that we will not be moved again because of God's promises. There is no place left to go!

*"Also the tree of the field will yield its fruit, and the earth will yield its increase, and they will be secure on their land. Then they will know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bars of their yoke and have delivered them from the hand of those who enslaved them. And they will no longer be a prey to the nations, and the beasts of the earth will not devour them; but they will live securely, and no one will make them afraid. And I will establish for them a renowned planting place, and they will not again be victims of famine in the land, and they will not endure the insults of the nations anymore. Then they will know that I, the LORD their God, am with them, and that they, the house of Israel, are My people," declares the Lord God. Ezekiel 34:27-30*

We have gun control, obama-care, drones, an obamnation in the president's chair, rigged elections across the board, unjust court systems, pimp's in the pulpits, homosexuals in our streets, cross dressers in the dressing rooms (and restrooms), and numerous other atrocities (too many to list). But it is all an opportunity for us to forcefully nullify and say, "NO," and at the same time having no fear or at least minimizing it as much as possible, keeping in mind Philippians 1:28. Also keep in mind:

*Let no one in any way deceive you, for it will not come unless the apostasy comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, who opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God. Do you not remember that while I was still with you, I was telling you these things? And you know what restrains him now, so that in his time he will be revealed. For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only he who now restrains will do so until he is taken out of the way. Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming; that is, the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders, and with all the deception of wickedness for those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth so as to be saved. For this reason God will send upon them a deluding influence so that they will believe what is false, in order that they all may be judged who did not believe the truth, but took pleasure in wickedness.*

2 Thessalonians 2:3-12

Being negative against the negative, ungodly things in the world can be a good thing; as long as we know how to use the power of "NO." It is another weapon that they can't regulate or negotiate away. The worst thing is, we can fail to recognize it or utilize it. In closing I will leave you with one more Bible verse:

*For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh, for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ, and we are ready to punish all disobedience, whenever your obedience is complete.*

2 Corinthians 10:3-6

And LORD, for those double minded, so-called Christians who cry out "*judge not*" and then judge us for so praying and saying so; have mercy on them and wake them as per the prophecy of Isaiah 52:1-2. LORD, we wish Your will to be done on earth, and so we pray Your Word which is Your will, for the alien, sons of hell, snake dog bastards, and brute beast Babylon minded whores.

And yes, LORD we know we get them courtesy of our sins, and You are keeping Your Word. But now we bring them before Your throne and ask for Your judgment upon them.

## April Prayer

We are reminded of the truths found in 2 Chronicles 7:14, and we pray Your Words of Psalm 69:22-29. *May their table before them become a snare; And when they are in peace, may it become a trap. May their eyes grow dim so that they cannot see, And make their loins shake continually. Pour out Thine indignation on them, And may Thy burning anger overtake them. May their camp be desolate; May none dwell in their tents. For they have persecuted him whom Thou Thyself hast smitten, And they tell of the pain of those whom Thou hast wounded. Do Thou add iniquity to their iniquity, And may they not come into Thy righteousness. May they be blotted out of the book of life, And may they not be recorded with the righteous. But I am afflicted and in pain; May Thy salvation, O God, set me securely on high.*

We pray the words of Isaiah 22:17-19 over the entire snakesden that conspire against Your chosen people. *"Behold, the LORD is about to hurl you headlong, O man. And He is about to grasp you firmly, And roll you tightly like a ball, To be cast into a vast country; There you will die, And there your splendid chariots will be, You shame of your master's house.' And I will depose you from your office, And I will pull you down from your station."*

We pray as did You and Your Son and as is recorded in Psalm 22:20. *"Deliver my soul from the sword, My only life from the power of the dog. Save me from the lion's mouth; And from the horns of the wild oxen Thou dost answer me."*

Deliver us from the conspiracies of men and the schemes of the devil as we stomp them under the soles of our boots! Let Your wrath and righteous indignation, that has been directed to us, Your faithless people, be completed. Let Your anger and punishment that we have been under be finished.

Oh LORD, see what our enemy has planned, that they intend to destroy Your people completely. We plead for You, Almighty God, to intercede for us before we are consumed by the evil ones of today. Destroy them before they destroy us.

We trust in You, who created the very heavens and the earth and all that dwell therein; We trust in You who are always faithful and have always delivered Your remnant.

In Jesus' Name we pray, Amen.
